About: 2-Hour daily mini-camp designed to create a positive and engaging environment where players can improve their skills while enjoying time on court.

For beginner and intermediate players, the focus will be on developing comfort with the ball and racquet while building key skills such as ball control, placement, and learning to hit different shot shapes. Players will also participate in games and point-based activities that encourage learning through play, helping to build confidence on the court.

For advanced players, emphasis will be on improving consistency, shot selection and rally tolerance. Additional focus will be placed on movement, defensive skills, and learning how to stay in points under pressure. Players will also work on recognizing opportunities to move forward, transition from defense to offense, and construct points more effectively.

The goal of the program is to provide a fun and supportive setting where players can improve their tennis, compete, and enjoy the game.

FRC summer programs do not allow makeups for missed classes; pro-rating will only be given for withdrawal once the camp session has started if a paid replacement can be found. Notice of withdrawal must be sent by email to memberservices@fairfaxracquetclub.com by no later than 12pm on the Wednesday before the camp starts. Class times are subject to change depending on overall enrollment. Refunds will be given if the adjusted class time is not suitable.
